### All-Terrain Vehicles



All-terrain vehicles may only be operated between the hours of sunrise and sunset within city limits. Any person operating an all-terrain vehicle within the City of Hartington, shall have a valid Class O operator's license and have liability insurance coverage while operating vehicle on a highway or street, and shall not operate such vehicle at a speed in excess of the posted speed limit, but in no event in excess of 30 mph. The headlights and taillights of the vehicle shall be on and the vehicle to be equipped with a day-glow color triangular safety flag. (Ord 89-802)

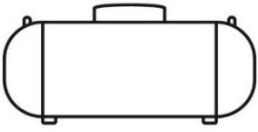
### Do You Need a Permit?

## The Newest Ordinance No. 903

*Underground storage of Liquefied Petroleum Gases within residential area*

Underground L.P.G. tanks within residential districts shall be permitted if tank contains 125 gallons or less water capacity and can be placed at a minimum distance of no less than twenty-five (25) feet from any building or line of adjoining property. If you are storing liquefied petroleum gas you first need to obtain a permit from City Council. You will need approval by the Fire Chief and all plans and drawings showing tank installation will be required. ## Did You Know?

Did you know that tree limbs that overhangs a sidewalk must be at **least eight ft (8')** above the sidewalk or a clearance of **fifteen ft (15')** must be maintained over city alleys and streets from the curb out into the street? It is the responsibility of the property owner to maintain the tree limbs height. (Ord 6683)
