A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HARTINGTON, NEBRASKA, TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE STATE HIGHWAY 57 PURSUANT TO NEB.REV.ST 39-1359 FOR THE PURPOSE OF A SPECIAL EVENT: FLY BY NIGHTS FIREWORKS SHOW.

WHEREAS, Fly By Night Fireworks will be conducting their annual Fly By Night Fireworks Show within the city limits of Hartington, Nebraska, and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARTINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. This is notice to the Nebraska Department of Transportation, District Three that Fly By Night Fireworks will hold their annual Fireworks Show on Tuesday, June 30, 2026 between the hours of 7:30 P.M. and 11:00 P.M. Please see attached map showing the section of Highway 57 that will be closed to ensure the safety of all attendees. Highway 57 will be closed from the intersection of West Franklin and Highway 57 to the intersection of West Bow and Highway 57.
2. During the Fireworks Show, the city will comply by providing law enforcement traffic control. Barricades will be set up at the intersection of West Franklin and Highway 57 and the intersection of West Bow and Highway 57. Safety personnel will be present to warn travelers.
3. The City of Hartington accepts all duties set out in Subsection (2) of LB589/N.R.S. Section 39-1359.
4. That if a claim is made against the state, the City shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the state from all claims, demands, actions, damages, and liability, including reasonable attorney's fees, that may arise as a result of the special event.
